These include Schulich's Centre of Excellence in Responsible Business, the Centre for Global Enterprise and the newly established Brookfield Centre in Real Estate and Infrastructure.



At the event, guests learned about the School's new comprehensive fundraising and alumni engagement campaign called Leading Change. 
