Starting in May 2019, Schulich's **Master of Supply Chain Management (MSCM)** will prepare graduates to design creative supply chain solutions to address business opportunities and problems in private, nonprofit, or governmental sectors.

MSCM candidates will gain knowledge of the latest concepts and methods in designing supply chains, while growing critical relationship-building skills needed to serve organizational functions, suppliers and customers.

Curriculum Highlights

Students will evaluate contemporary industry and management issues using qualitative and quantitative data, while also taking into account the wider contexts of risk, ambiguity and corporate responsibility in a global environment.

The program culminates in a collaborative Supply Chain Consulting Project, providing students the opportunity to practice their teamwork and presentation skills as they explore opportunities and solutions for a local client organization.

Flexible Study Options

For those currently working in industry, the MSCM is structured to allow part-time enrolment. Students enrolled full-time can finish the program in one year, while part-time students can finish in two years. Certain qualified candidates may be eligible for Advanced Standing in the program, allowing for completion in as little as eight months.

Advanced Standing

If you hold a **Bachelor of Business Administration degree from the Schulich School of Business**, you may be eligible for Advanced Standing to Term 2 of the MSCM program. If you hold a **Bachelor of Business Administration or Bachelor of Commerce degree obtained within the last ten years from a recognized North American business school**, you may request an assessment for Advanced Standing from our Graduate Admissions team. Note that you must have a **minimum B grade** in all applicable courses. If granted, Advanced Standing would allow you to enter the program at Term 2 in September and complete your degree in eight months (two terms) of full-time study or 20 months (four terms) of part-time study.
