



The search process for the future Dean of the Schulich School of Business is now underway. The Schulich Global Alumni Network has been allocated **one seat** on the Decanal Search Committee.

The selection of the future Dean represents a pivotal moment for your alma mater and the involvement of the Global Alumni Network is very important.

If you are interested in this opportunity, the self-nomination process is now open to all Schulich alumni. Some helpful information is provided below.

What is the purpose of the Decanal Search Committee?

Over the next year, the Decanal Search Committee will undertake the search process for the future Dean of the Schulich School of Business at York University. Key responsibilities of this Committee include but are not limited to: crafting the position profile; consulting with Schulich community stakeholders; working with a search consultant to initiate the global call for applications; distilling a short-list of candidates; conducting the interview process; and making a recommendation to the President on the future Dean.

Who else will be on the Decanal Search Committee?

The Decanal Search Committee will include the following stakeholders: Schulich faculty (full-time and part-time); students (undergraduate and masters-level); administrative staff members; and, a Schulich alumni representative. The former Dean of Law at York University's Osgoode Hall Law School, Dr. Lorne Sossin, will also be a member of the Committee as the President's designate. Interim Provost and Vice-President Academic, Professor Lisa Philipps, will chair the Decanal Search Committee.

How do I self-nominate?

Like all other stakeholder seats on the Decanal Search Committee, the Alumni Representative will be elected by her/his peers (i.e., other alumni). All alumni interested in the Decanal Search Committee must self-nominate to stand for election.

All alumni candidates self-nominating for the representative seat are required to provide a brief candidate statement of up to 150 words. This candidate statement must be submitted by **June 11th, 2018 (12 midnight ET) to the Schulich Alumni Relations Office at www.schulich.yorku.ca/alumni/selfnomination**

Candidates will be invited to use their candidate statement to respond to the following question: "*What expertise and strengths do you bring to the Committee?*". Candidate statements will be posted in the Schulich Online Alumni Community ("Schulich Alumni Connect") at schulichalumniconnect.com on **June 13th, 2018** for review. On **June 15th, 2018**, the Alumni Relations Office will circulate a link to the secure voting page.

Who is eligible to self-nominate for the alumni seat on the Decanal Search Committee?

You are eligible to self-nominate if you hold one or more of the following Schulich degrees: BBA, iBBA, MBA, IMBA, MBA/JD, MBA/MA/MFA, EMBA, MF, MBAN (formerly known as MSc Business Analytics), MAcc, MREI, MMgt (formerly known as MSTM), PhD or one of the graduate diploma programs or post-MBA diploma/certificate programs.

What are the expectations for Decanal Search Committee members?

In addition to being excited and passionate about Schulich's future, Decanal Search Committee members are expected to be knowledgeable and informed about Schulich's current strengths, achievements, and opportunities for growth.

The Decanal Search Committee will meet several times over the next year and require several hours/days of your time, including the possibility of some weekend or evening meetings. Most meetings will be held in-person at the Keele Campus, but it is anticipated that some video conference/conference call options will be made available occasionally. Given the importance of the Committee's work, attendance is required for all meetings.
