Semester fulfillment	- Students must have completed at least 2 semesters (Undergraduate)/ 1 semester(post-graduate) or equivalent before application opens.				
	* The official transcript uploaded must show official and final grades for these semesters. * It must be in English, signed or stamped by home university (Digital signature is accepted). * For transfer students, a minimum of one semester's result at the transferred university is required on the official transcript.				
GPA	- 2.5 / 4.0 (B average) or above - ECTS (C or above)				
Passport	- Students must hold a passport with the expiration date at least 6 months left from the starting date of the semester.				
Language Proficiency	- ENGLISH : If you plan to take courses taught in English , <u>TOEFL cBT 213(iBT 79, pBT 550) or IELTS 6.5</u> is required.				
	* Native English speakers & non-native speakers studying their degree in English are waived.				
	- KOREAN : If you plan to take courses taught in Korean , <i>KLAT level 4</i> , or an assessment report by a professor is required.				
	* Students must get permission from the professor on the 1st day of class.

Visa

A Student Visa (D-2) is required. For detailed instructions and requirements, please consult your local Korean Embassy or Consulate. Yonsei will provide the Certificate of Enrolment and the Certificate of Business Registration, which are two essential documents for visa application.

(*) Please note that as of February 2021, no foreign national can enter Korea without a valid immigration status(a visa), even if s/he is from a visa-waiver country. This measure is closely related to the COVID-19 situation both in and outside of Kore and is subject to change. Please consult your nearest Korean Consulate for the most up-to-date information.

Health Insurance

All incoming exchange & visiting students are obligated to obtain personal health insurance. Please enroll in a health insurance plan of your choice, as there is no designated insurance service provider but it is recommended that you choose a study abroad plan which will cover medical expenses to be incurred during your exchange in Korea. Mandatory insurance plans provided at your home institution will be sufficient, but proof (an official letter) must be provided. The proof of health insurance should include the name of the insured, period and place of coverage. Student will have to pay the full fee up front, and then apply to his/her home insurance company for some form of reimbursement.
