PREPARING TO ARRIVE IN CANADA Immigration Documents

- International students studying for longer than 6 months require a <u>study permit</u> to study inside Canada
 - As a current student, you should already have applied for your study permit
 - <u>For PGWP eligibility</u>, must apply for study permit before starting your program
 - Study permit approval is not required before starting online from overseas (but is required if you are physically in Canada)
- Depending on your <u>country of citizenship</u>, you will also be issued a temporary resident visa (TRV) or electronic travel authorization (eTA) to enter Canada (exception for US citizens)
- Upon approval, you should receive a <u>Letter of Introduction</u> from the visa office; required to board a flight
- Study permit will be issued at the border when you arrive
- Remember, being exempt from the travel restrictions and authorized to board your flight does not guarantee that you will be permitted entry to Canada
 - o Entry to Canada is at discretion of border officer
- Continue to monitor <u>IRCC COVID-19 website</u>

PREPARING TO ARRIVE IN CANADA PGWP Update

On February 12, the Canadian government announced that PGWP measures will be <u>extended and</u> <u>expanded</u>

- ALL online studies completed overseas will <u>count toward PGWP eligibility</u>, up to 31 December 2021
 - $\circ~$ Can complete 100% of your program online from outside Canada
 - \circ $\,$ No longer required to complete 50% of program in Canada
 - Must still meet other eligibility requirements (i.e.: full-time studies; no unauthorized breaks)
 - o Adds flexibility to travel plans
- Summer 2021 term will continue online
- A partial return to in-person classes is anticipated for Fall 2021
 - Availability depends on program/level

PREPARING TO ARRIVE IN CANADA

Travel Restrictions/Exemptions

Travel exemptions for international students:

- 1. Must have appropriate travel documents (i.e: study permit approval)
 - Visa/eTA/US passport and Letter of Introduction from visa office
- 2. University must have an approved COVID-readiness plan
 - York University is an approved DLI
- 3. Must have negative COVID test taken within 72 hrs of departure
- 4. Cannot be entering Canada for an optional purpose*
 - Must be enrolled in classes or will be starting classes within 3-4 weeks after arrival
- 5. Must have valid immigration medical exam
 - Exams are valid for 1 year from date of exam
 - There is no vaccine requirement for Canada (at this time)
- 6. Must have plan to <u>quarantine for 14 days</u> after arrival
 - York University is offering quarantine accommodation upon request
- 7. Must undergo COVID test upon arrival
- 8. Monitor country-specific travel bans (India/Pakistan)

*Optional/non-optional purpose of travel

- Students meeting above criteria will be considered to be travelling for a <u>non-optional purpose</u>, regardless of mode of program delivery (online/in-person)
- Must show proof of enrollment; request <u>Confirmation of Enrollment with Entry Support</u> Letter from Schulich



You should **not** travel to Canada until 3-4 weeks before your classes begin

PREPARING TO ARRIVE IN CANADA Mandatory Quarantine

Upon arrival, required by law to immediately quarantine for 14 days; fines in place for non-compliance

- Must have a plan in place before travelling to fulfill <u>quarantine</u> <u>requirement</u>
 - 1) York U Quarantine Accommodation Program; **OR**
 - 2) Self-Arranged Quarantine
- <u>3-day initial quarantine</u> at government-authorized hotel is required to await COVID test results
 - <u>York U will arrange and cover this 3-day quarantine</u> in Ontario, regardless of what your quarantine plan is

York U Quarantine Accommodation Program

- No-cost quarantine hotel accommodations available (recommended)
- Visit <u>York U Quarantine webpage</u> for more information
- Note: York U hotel accommodation is a standard hotel (3-star)
 - Basic accommodations and meals; Requests for upgrades, etc cannot be considered

Self Arranged Quarantine

Review <u>quarantine requirements</u>

- The government plans to introduce quarantine amendment for fully vaccinated travelers
 - Health Canada approved vaccines
 - Anticipated mid July; details to come
- The Quarantine Accommodation program will be unavailable from June 21 – July 6

Mandatory! Must Complete York U <u>Quarantine Accommodation Form</u> at least 3 weeks before travel date, regardless of where you intend to quarantine

PREPARING TO ARRIVE IN CANADA Required Steps

Before travelling to Canada, you must complete the following:

Review York University Essential Information for International Travelers

University Requirements

At least 3 weeks before you travel:

- Complete the York University <u>Quarantine Accommodation Form</u>
- Request a <u>Confirmation of Enrollment with Entry Support letter</u> from Schulich

Canadian Government requirements

- Obtain <u>negative COVID test</u> taken within 72 hrs before travel
- Download the <u>ArriveCAN app</u> and submit your travel and quarantine information to the Canadian government before boarding your flight

PREPARING TO ARRIVE IN CANADA Vaccine Requirement – On Campus Housing

York University has implemented a vaccine requirement for students living in on-campus residence this fall.

Requirement for Vaccination

- Applies to students living in undergraduate residence in Fall 2021
 - Graduate students living in York Apartments are exempt, but strongly encouraged to be vaccinated
- Should have 1st shot before moving into residence (taken at least 14 days before move-in)
- Only <u>Health Canada</u> and <u>WHO</u> approved vaccines are accepted
- Students who cannot get vaccinated before move-in will have 14 days after move-in date to receive 1st dose
- York U will help to facilitate access to vaccines
- International students are eligible to receive vaccine in Canada at no charge

Accommodation

It is your responsibility to secure accommodations in Toronto. Consider the type of accommodation that is best for you by researching costs, location, etc.

On-Campus Housing – York Apartments (Graduate)

- Housing for graduate students and families
- Lease-based occupancy
- Furnished and unfurnished apartments you will need to obtain your own bedding, small kitchen appliances and other items

On-Campus Housing (Undergraduate) - **Vaccine required*

- 8 Residence buildings at York's Keele Campus
- Meal-Plan is available for students
- Variety of social and educational activities are provided for residence students

Off-Campus Housing

University Health Insurance Plan (UHIP)

- Mandatory for all international students and dependents who are physically in Canada Dependents must be enrolled within 30 days of arrival to avoid \$500 late fee
- Coverage includes services such as doctor's visits and hospital accommodation in Ontario and emergency services in Canada. UHIP only covers dental care required as a result of a major accident
- UHIP does not cover medications, routine dental care, etc (supplemental insurance recommended)
- The approximate cost is \$720 (Sept 1st Aug 31st)*
 - Only students in Canada will be enrolled. Must complete the Quarantine Accommodation form
 - Current students: Your coverage will begin as of your date of arrival in Canada; you should receive your UHIP card within a week (*check your junk mail*); if you do not receive it, complete the <u>UHIP Card Request form</u>

Graduate Student Association (GSA) / York Federation of Students (YFS) Supplemental Insurance

- Coverage includes items such as prescription drugs, paramedical services, dental benefits, etc.
- All full-time students will automatically be registered (dependents can be enrolled), regardless of country of residence
 - \circ $\,$ You may need to opt-in if you have not yet been enrolled
 - o Students not in Canada can opt out by selecting 'Coverage provided by foreign Governments'
 - \circ $\;$ To be exempt, students must provide proof of an alternative coverage
- For fees and to opt-in/opt-out, visit the <u>GSA website</u> (graduate) or the <u>YFS website</u> (undergrad)

Health plan fees will be billed to your student account Plan to attend a session in August for more details

PREPARING TO ARRIVE IN CANADA When to Arrive and What to Bring

Review what to <u>expect at the airport</u> when you arrive in Canada as an international student. If you are arriving as a permanent resident, please also review <u>PR arrival requirements</u>. **Download the** <u>ArriveCAN app</u>.

Living on-campus? - Check the move-in times/dates so you can plan your arrival, considering quarantine requirement

☑ Important Items to Pack

- Valid Passport, with your Temporary Resident Visa (TRV) / eTA; or US passport*
- □ Letter of Introduction letter from visa office*
- □ Your Schulich Letter of Acceptance (*printed copy acceptable*)*
- Confirmation of Enrollment with Entry Support letter (recently dated) *
- □ Proof of funds*
- □ Quarantine Plan*
- □ Ensure your immigration medical exam is still valid
- Photocopies/digital copies of important documents (and send to your email)
- □ Proof of vaccine, if applicable
- Medications, health documents and prescriptions (if applicable); check <u>import limits</u> for medications

ARRIVAL IN TORONTO

Transport from Pearson International Airport

COVID-19: You MUST use private transportation from the airport; you are prohibited from using public transportation (bus, subway, train); shuttle provided for York U Quarantine

Airport Taxi (recommended)

- Taxi fares from the airport are based on a flat rate tariff.
- Fare : **\$50-60 CAD** approximately (tips and extra luggage fee extra).
- Travel time: 30 minutes to York campus.
- Taxis will be waiting once you exit the airport terminal. Use only authorized taxi providers.

Ride-Hailing Apps

- Use <u>Uber</u> or <u>Lyft</u> to and from airport
- Fare: approximately \$50 from airport to York U
- Uber Rider kiosk available as you leave baggage area



COVID-19 IN TORONTO

What does this mean for me?

Ontario Public Health Measures

- Step 1 of the <u>Roadmap to Reopen</u>, as of June 11
- Restrictions remain in effect <u>https://covid-19.ontario.ca/public-health-measures</u>
 - o Many businesses remain limited or closed
 - Work remotely where possible
 - Must wear a mask in all indoor public spaces, including transit system
 - Must practice physical distancing (2 metres apart)
 - Not permitted to gather indoors with anyone you do not live with
 - No indoor events permitted; outside events limited to 10 people
- Monitor the <u>Toronto COVID-19 website</u> and <u>Toronto Public Health Measures</u>







ARRIVAL IN TORONTO COVID-19 at York U

As York U community members, we all have a responsibility to keep the campus safe

- In Level 1 of <u>Welcoming YU Back Roadmap</u>
- Before entering campus, must complete <u>COVID Screening Checklist</u>
- <u>Daily screening</u> required for those living on campus
- Vaccination required for on-campus undergrad residence
- Cannot enter campus if you have been outside Canada in previous 14 days
- Must wear a mask in all indoor spaces (i.e.: York Lanes, common areas in residence)
- Most buildings and services are closed on campus
 - All indoor fitness facilities
 - In-door dining (take out still available at some restaurants)
- Remote services are available such as mental health and wellness, academic advising, etc
- Must practice physical distancing

ARRIVAL AT YORK UNIVERSITY Know your Campus

LIVING IN TORONTO Public Transportation

Toronto Transit Commission (TTC)



- Fare: \$3.25 cash (drivers do not give back change), \$3.20 Presto
- Serves City of Toronto
- The subway system connects with buses and streetcars.
- Closest stop: York University station .

Paying on the TTC:

- Reloadable Presto card is recommended (purchase at station or Shoppers Drug Mart at York Lanes)
- Can retap Presto card within 2 hrs of 1st tap and not charged

GO Transit

- Connects to out-of-town locations: Mississauga, Brampton, Hamilton, Scarborough, Milton etc.
- Closest bus stop: Highway 407 Bus Terminal. .
- Fare : \$3-\$20 PRESTO (depending on the distance)

York Region Transit (VIVA/YRT)



- Fare: \$4 cash, \$3.75 PRESTO
- Serves areas north of York University (York Region)
- Closest stop: Pioneer Village TTC station

Brampton Transit (ZÜM)

- Fare: \$4 cash, \$3.75 PRESTO
- Serves Brampton region
- Closest stop: 5 min walk north of Schulich on Ian McDonald Blvd

- Fare: \$3.75 cash, \$3.10 PRESTO
- Serves Mississauga region
- Closest stop: Islington TTC station

Union Pearson (UP) Express

- Fare: \$12.35 by cash/credit card; or \$9.35 by PRESTO
- Union Station to Toronto Pearson Airport

ARRIVAL IN TORONTO Presto Card

PRESTO is accepted on all GTA transit systems

- Purchase a PRESTO card
 - o <u>Online</u>
 - o at a PRESTO vending machine (TTC subway stations)
 - o at a customer service outlet
 - o at Shopper's Drug Mart locations that sell PRESTO cards
- Cost: \$6 for card + \$0.05 minimum load/reload if purchased in person or \$5/\$10 minimum from a vending machine
- Load in advance may take up to 24 hours to reload on-line
- Manage your card at: My PRESTO to add funds & passes and manage your profile
- Fares may vary between systems
- Additional fare when transferring between systems
- Tap your card to pay
- Hop on/off any direction for 2 hours without being charged again from the 1st time you tap on
- Research <u>Post-Secondary Monthly Pass</u> on PRESTO to save money on each transportation system
