COURSE DETAILS

Eligibility & Scheduling

Prerequisites:

- MBA or IMBA student
- All 5100-series Required Foundations of Management courses completed prior to the Winter 2022 term
 - Consideration will be given to students who had approval to defer a 5100-level course to the Winter 2022 term in order to register in an elective course to count towards their specialization.

Course Credits:

- The Study Tour Course enrolment is for the Winter 2022 term
 - Part-time students have the option to enrol the course in either the Winter 2022 or Summer 2022 term
- Students can register as a 3.0 or 1.5 credit hour Study Tour course
 - 1.5 credit hour Study Tour has fewer deliverables
- Students are responsible for managing the course enrolment once permission to enrol is granted from Student & Enrolment Services
 - Standard add/drop deadlines and regulations apply

Note: Students must enrol in course credits and have sufficient credit space

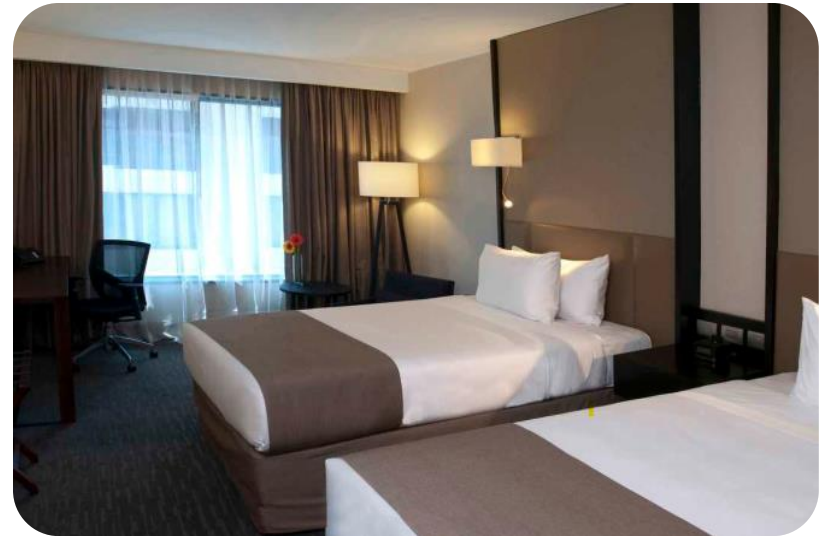

TRIP DETAILS

Costs

Study Tour:

- \$1882 USD* (approx. \$2350 CAD)
 - Single Supplement +\$434 USD
 - **final cost to be set; determined by number of participants*

Inclusions:

- Accommodation for 6 nights (dual occupancy), all breakfasts, welcome dinner, internet, city tours, trip to Chilean coast, ground transportation, company visits, gratuities, farewell lunch

Additional:

- Flights, travel health insurance, visas (if applicable), food not included in itinerary

TRIP DETAILS

COVID Safety

Safety and security of all participants is top priority. COVID protocols will be in place to mitigate risk :

- All participants required to be fully vaccinated and adhere to COVID requirements of destination country
- Country risk assessment monitored regularly to ensure safe environment for travel
 - Currently, Chile has achieved an 87% vaccination rate
- Pre-departure training/orientation
- Vendor has Risk Management team and internal protocols to deal with emergency scenarios, including on-the-ground team in Chile
- Vendor will have strict protocols in place with respect to transportation, company visits, hotels, restaurants, etc
 - Thorough vetting of all providers
 - Physical distancing
 - Masks

REGISTRATION

How Do I Sign Up?

Step One. Reserve your space on the registration site (first-come first-served basis)

- Registration opens: Wednesday, November 10, 2021 at 11:30am EST
- 32 seats for MBA/IMBA students– if full, add your name to the waitlist

Step Two. Submit your \$500 deposit within 48 hours of registration

- Deposits are non-refundable however, if there is a waitlist, the deposit may be refundable if the space can be transferred to the next student on the waitlist up until January 6, 2022. Payment for the remainder of the study tour must be made by January 10, 2022.

Step Three. You will be sent an email to enrol in the course through Passport York later in the term

Step Two – Submit Your Deposit

Chile Study Tour: May 1-7, 2022

Students must register prior to making a deposit. Deposits received that are not associated with a successful registration will not be granted a space in the course. Registrants will be given 48 hours to complete their deposit upon receiving the payment page link. Failure to do so will result in the space being given to the next student on the waitlist.

To secure your space in the May 2022 Chile Study Tour, please submit your \$500 CAD deposit.

IMPORTANT NOTES:

Space Allocation: Open to students who meet course prerequisites. Spaces in the program are reserved on a first-come first-served basis by completion of the registration form (limited spaces available).

Payment Schedule & Cancellation Policy:

Deposits are non-refundable however, if there is a waitlist, the deposit may be refundable if the space can be transferred to the next student on the waitlist up until January 6, 2022. Payment for the remainder of the study tour must be made by January 10, 2022. Any remaining payments made by the cancelled participant may be refundable if the space can be transferred to the next student on the waitlist (if available) prior to the first day of class on January 10, 2022. Cancellations after January 10, 2022 will not receive a refund of program fees. Participants are advised to purchase cancellation insurance to mitigate the risk of any personal emergency that may result in cancellation.

In the event that the minimum number of participants is not met, the Schulich School of Business will cancel the program and students will receive a full refund of their payments to date (including deposit).

All participating students will be required to register in the study tour course, attend a pre-departure session, obtain international travel and medical insurance (with COVID-19 coverage), required immunization/health documentation including COVID-19 vaccination, visas (if applicable), and complete waiver and emergency contact forms prior to departure.
