

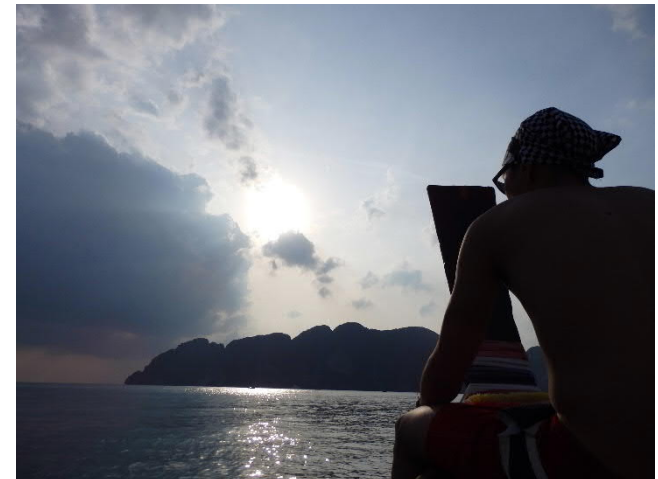

Language Advantage

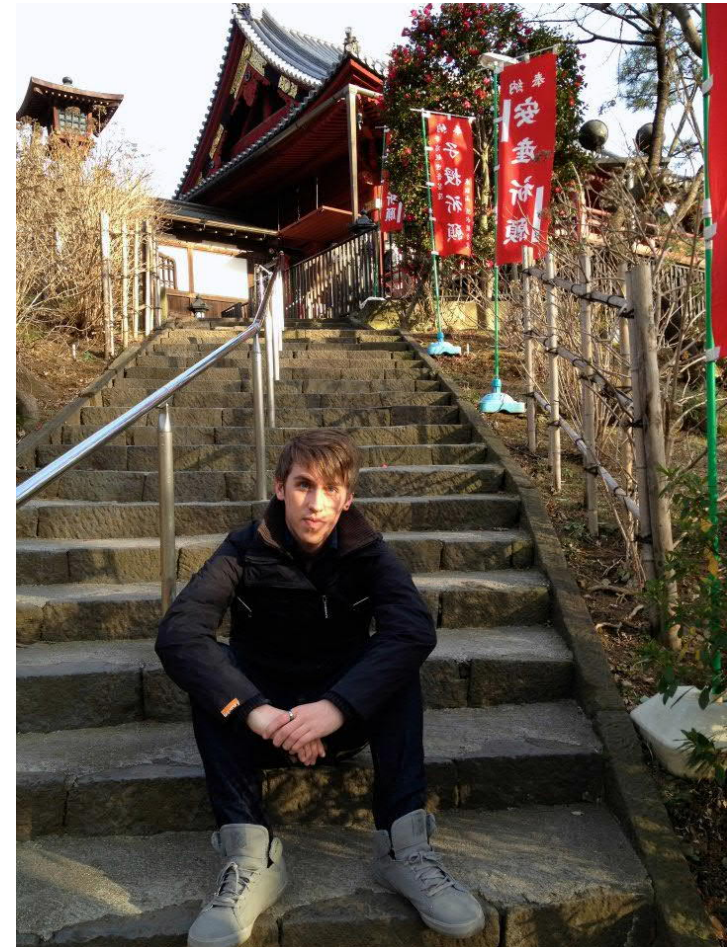
Learn a new language or become fluent

- exceptions – some Latin American schools (limited English)

Take business courses in local language if comfortable

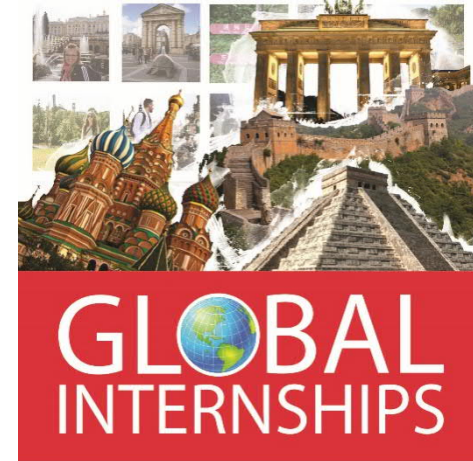
Receive credits for completing a Summer internship abroad

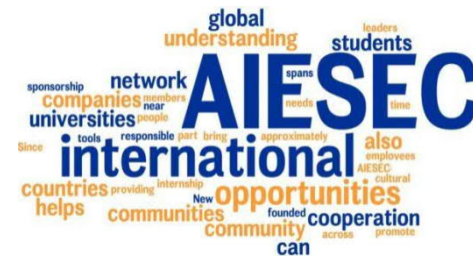
Add onto an exchange or Summer program

Types of Internships

1. Remote Internships
2. Internship Provider (Year-round)
3. Direct Partner (Summer semester)

Funding

- Potential from York International Internship award (YIIA) to help offset expenses

Start Date

- Summer from May to August - start & end dates vary
- 3 months

Application Process

- Deadline: January 23rd, 2023
- Complete an online application
 - Applications open in mid-October
 - Apply for a maximum of 3 positions
- Upload resume (maximum 2 pages)
 - Tip: Have resume reviewed by Career Centre

Tuition paid to York U + Admin Fee + Accommodations + Living and Travel Expenses

Short term commitment

Any Summer after 2nd year to Graduation

Academic Planning

Students must study full-time while on exchange

Min 12 and max 15 credits

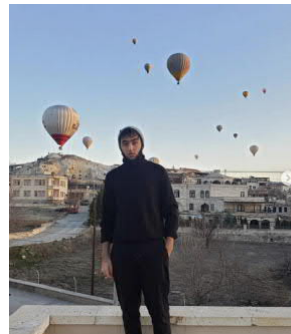
CPA – Winter 3rd year

Exchange grades will appear as pass or fail on York transcript

Passes will not affect GPA, fails will result in a 0

iBBAs must complete min 6 credits of language intermediate level or higher before exchange term

Year 4 Winter Exchange = October convocation

Application Process

Three Phases

The exchange application process falls into three phases:

Phase 1 – Research & Application
Completed by student

Phase 2 – Interview
Completed by student & Exchange Selection Committee

Phase 3 – Selection – Matching Student to School
Evaluation & decision by Exchange Selection Committee

Application Deadline

Phase One

DEADLINE: November 14, 2022

Application Details

Online Application Form: Demographics, School Choices w/ weighting
iBBA priority spots

3 criteria used to choose schools

How did you narrow down your choices?

Proposed Study Plan – for top 3 schools

Resume – maximum 2 pages

Basic – employment and cocurricular/community involvement

One Proposed Budget

Use a range if schools/countries have varied costs

One Language Referee – Academic

if study plan includes non-English courses, exception: language study

Application Bonus

OPTIONAL: Bonus Creative submission

Show us your passion for exchange by expressing your creativity. Some ideas for creative submission (but not limited to):

- Video
- Infographic
- Song/Rap/Spoken word
- Painting/drawing/graphic design
- Dance via video

**Any video/audio submissions must be maximum 1 minute. Any written, graphic or other formats must be 1 page maximum.

Interviews

Phase Two

Individual Interviews begin late-November

Via Zoom

Go until March

Students will schedule their preferred timeslot via web link upon submission of online application

Prepare for questions about criteria, school choices and overall intention and goals for exchange, potential scenario

Optional: discuss creative submission

Matching & Selection

Phase Three

Scored based on:

- Rationale of exchange choices
 - Academic, professional, personal goals
- Attitude towards global experience
- Ambassadorial skills

Evaluation ranking and available spaces

GPA

** We will do our best to match you to one of your listed choices, however, due to limited space availability, you may receive a list of alternative schools to select **

Pro Tips

Do's and Don'ts

DO YOUR RESEARCH – Know your stuff

Do be honest and sincere

Don't tell us what you think we want to hear

Do show/tell us your passion for exchange and experiencing new things

Don't tell us anything we can Google or find on the school website

Do submit app and prepare for interview like you would for your dream job

Do show us your personal and/or creative side (*we like that)

Applying with a Friend

- MUST be open
- More friends → lower school on list or no match at all
- Check spaces available at partner school
 - iBBA priority vs open
- Consider and list criteria appropriately
- Discuss with friends...
 - Need to vs would like to
