# Academic Matters

<b>Language of Instruction</b>	English
<b>Teaching Methods</b>	A variety: including lectures, case studies, presentations, project work, computer-based business games, multi-media tools and field trips. Students are expected to participate in class discussions.
<b>Class Size</b>	Average size of between 40 to 50 students
<b>Modular Credits (MC) / Hours</b>	2 MC (17-25 contact hours) or 4 MC (39 contact hours).
<b>Course Load</b>	Recommended minimum of 3 modules (12 Modular Credits) to maximum of 4 modules (16 Modular Credits). Students may take up to 4 modules (16 Modular Credits) or more modules, subjected to availability.

DT	5.00	Distinction	Given to the top 15%–25% of students in an elective module.
M	4.00	Merit	Given to the next 65%–75% in an elective module
P	3.00	Pass	Given to the lowest-performing 10% of students in a module
