## **NOMINATIONS & APPLICATION PROCESS**

- > Partners nominate students via an online form sent by email to the partner institution's international office
- > After being officially nominated, students receive an email with instructions to apply via an online portal

# MINIMUM LEVEL OF STUDY REQUIRED

3rd year Bachelor (minimum age 21) and Master students are welcome

## **LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS**

- > English TOEFL iBT 90, IELTS 6.5 for courses in English
- > French B2+ DELF for courses in French Students exempt from proving language proficiency:
- > Native speakers
- > Students who are currently undertaking a degree taught in English

#### **COURSE INFORMATION**

The Course Catalogue is provided before the start of the semester by email. Courses open to exchange students:

- > Master 1 and Master 2 level management courses
- > International Seminars and Electives: courses with transversal management themesn.

#### LANGUAGE OF INSTRUCTION

- > 150 courses in English
- > 200 courses in French

#### **COURSE REGISTRATION**

During the application process, students will receive instructions for providing their course selection.

#### **HOURS AND CREDITS PER COURSE**

- > 24 contact hours per course
- > 3 ECTS per course (ECTS = European Credit Transfer System)

#### **WORK LOAD**

Minimum Load: 4 courses (or 12 ECTS) per semester Maximum Load: 10 courses (or 30 ECTS) per semester

#### **COURSE SCHEDULE**

Courses are organized in clusters of three or six hours per day throughout the semester or in intensive format. Exams are scheduled at the end of each course so there is not one specific exam period for all of the courses.

#### **GRADING SCALE**

- > 0-20 scale to express all assessment scores
- > 0 (worst) to 20 (best), 10 = pass/credit

## STUDENT HOUSING

Incoming exchange students have the opportunity to reserve a room at Crous Cité Estelan located in Aix-en-Provence. Students receive instructions from the International Relations team for applying when the reservation period starts.

#### INTENSIVE FRENCH LANGUAGE

IAE Aix-Marseille offers language instruction of French as a foreign language for exchange students:

- > 2-week intensive course prior to the Fall semester
- > Courses during the Fall and Spring semesters

Free for exchange students and the beginner course is only offered during the Fall semester.

# **ORIENTATION & ADVICE SESSIONS**

An Orientation Day is scheduled at the beginning of the semester. Online Advice Sessions are organized prior to the semester for preparing your stay and answering questions.
