

Schulich's graduate diplomas in the field of Global Metals and Minerals Management (GMM) address an unfilled need for responsible leaders in the global metals and minerals industry. The innovative programs utilize an integrated, blended learning approach to develop leadership skills, global perspectives, and responsible behaviours in graduates.

Two Diploma Programs

Concurrent GMM Diploma for MBA students

The Concurrent GMM Diploma program is designed for existing Schulich MBA students who seek to strengthen their knowledge in the metals and minerals value chain and enhance their leadership skills.

Standalone GMM Diploma

The Standalone GMM Diploma is designed for business professionals currently working part- or full-time in the metals and minerals industry who would like to further develop their leadership skills while deepening their knowledge of the metals and minerals value chain.

Innovative Program Design

The GMM Diplomas are based on two key curriculum innovations, a blended-learning format and an integrated, experiential teaching approach. The blended-learning format includes on demand and live online components as well as two 1-week residences. These residences will bring students from around the globe together at an off-site location (first residence) or at the School's Keele Campus (second residence). Both weeks include a mix of minilectures, workshop-style classes, seminars, group work, group coaching, guest speakers, engagement with local businesses and stakeholders, site visits, and social activities. Students will be fully immersed in the metals and minerals value chain while forming relationships with colleagues, industry professionals, stakeholders, and instructors.
