He currently serves as Chief Services Officer at Altrio, a fast-growing PropTech company transforming how institutional investors source, evaluate, and execute deals. Akin leads the strategic development of Altrio's Data Services and Professional Services, and plays a central role in advancing Altrio, the firm's AI-enabled deal management and execution platform,

where automation and data intelligence reshape sourcing, evaluation, and decision-making for global CRE investors.

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His edge is a combination that the market is only beginning to value: AI governance fluency, data-management discipline, and demonstrated applied delivery. He is actively deepening that foundation across AI governance, enterprise data management, and executive data and AI leadership, pairing hands-on technical development with the governance and management frameworks that regulated industries increasingly demand.
